The Bridge is expanding and adding 4 bilingual counselors to join our Family Stabilization Team. As a member of a community focused intervention team, this position works with children and families on the verge of breakdown, with youth who refuse to attend school regularly, and with youth who have come into contact with the police. The Bridge team works with families to deflect them from the Department of Children and Family Services and Juvenile Justice.

This position will be on-call once per week and rotating weekends. We work with local schools and police departments in Palatine Township, Maine Township, Hanover, Schaumburg and Elk Grove Village.

The Bridge is an equal opportunity employer. Responsibilities

- Provide bilingual counseling services to families, focusing on behavioral therapy and child & family counseling.
- Conduct patient assessments and develop individualized treatment plans.
- Maintain accurate medical documentation and adhere to HIPAA regulations.
- Implement crisis intervention strategies.
- Collaborate with community resources to support families in need of home and community care.
- Engage in ongoing data collection to evaluate treatment effectiveness and adjust approaches as necessary.
- Carry a caseload of traditional therapy clients (up to 16).

Qualifications

- Bilingual proficiency in English and Spanish required
- Strong background in family and individual counseling.
- Familiarity with HIPAA regulations and medical documentation
- Skills in crisis intervention and motivational interviewing
- IMCANs Certification Strongly Preferred
- LSW/LPC Strongly Preferred - required within 6 month of hire.
